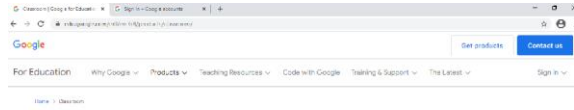


Completing work on Google Classroom

Choose **Go to Classroom**.

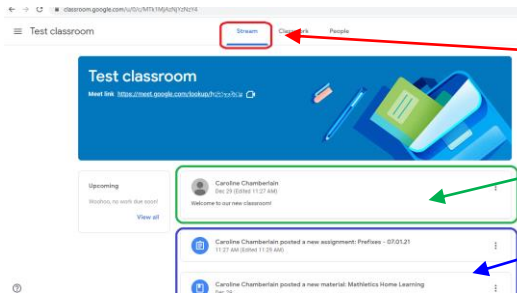
You will need to sign in with your username and password. You were given this on myUSO.

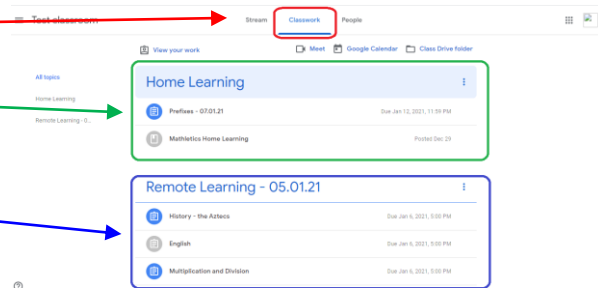


The **stream** tab shows:

Messages from your teachers and teaching assistants

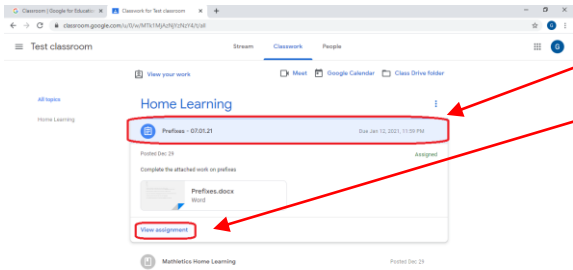
Home learning tasks

The **classwork** tab shows:



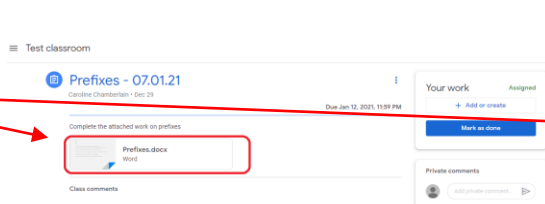
The home learning set for that week

The remote learning your class teacher has set for you if you are self-isolating



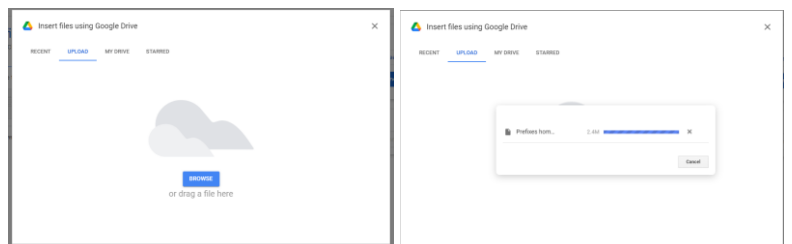
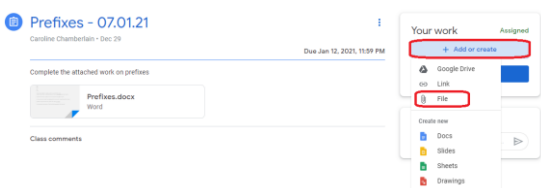
Click on the title of the home learning to view the assignment.

Click on any attachments to open them.

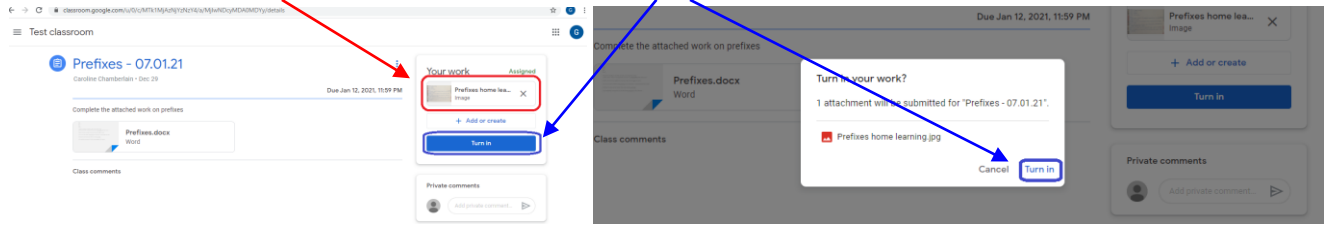


When you are ready to upload the work, click on **+ Add or create**, then **File**.

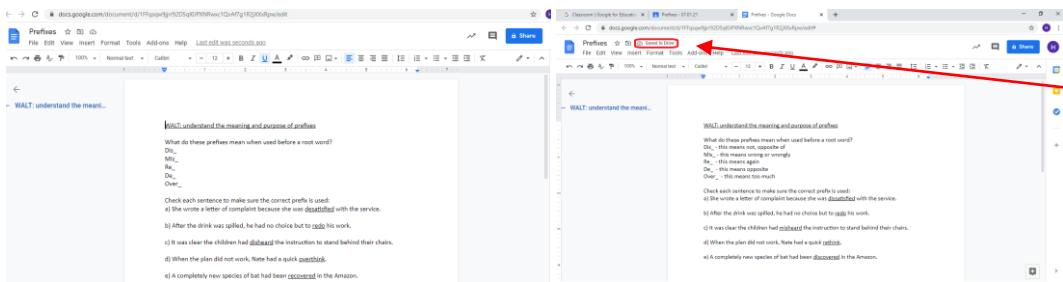
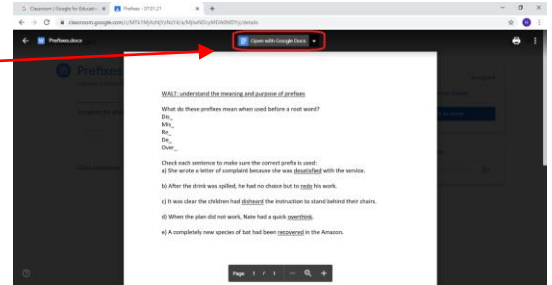
Browse to where the work is saved and upload it.



You will see that your file has been uploaded. Click on **Turn in**.

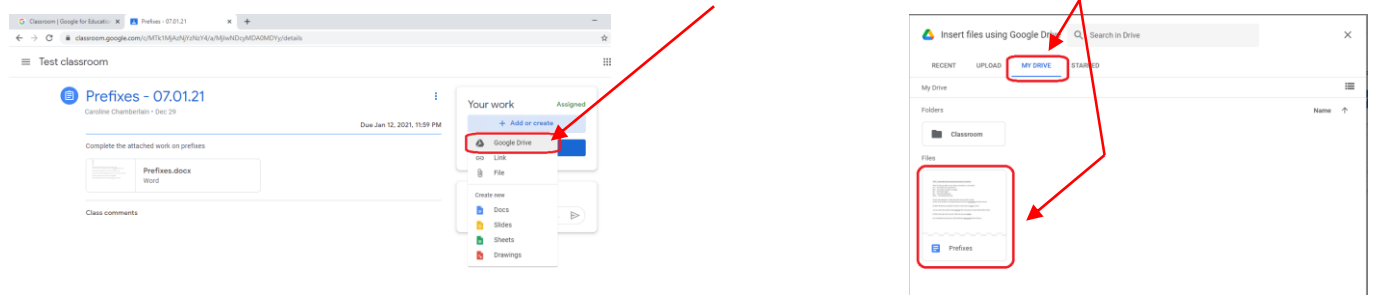


If your teacher has asked you to type your work on your computer or tablet, open it with Google Docs.

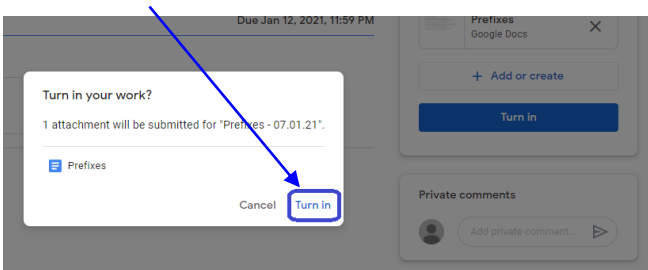


Your work will be saved automatically, and saved to your Google Drive.

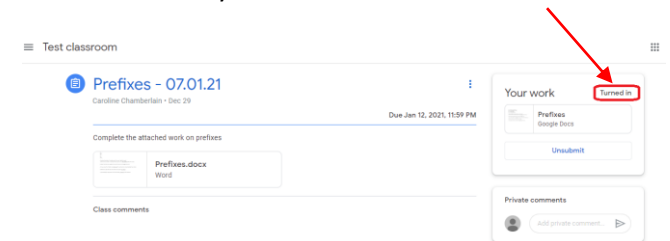
When you are ready to upload the work, click on **+ Add or create**, then **Google Drive**. Find the work.

You will see that your work has been submitted.
